- 1 Ring Youth Combined Senior & Junior Doe Show

Breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, AOP, Recorded Grade

Official Show Rules

1. This is a sanctioned show with the American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA). Therefore, ADGA Rules shall govern; all rules are subject to change.
2. This show is exclusively for youth exhibitors and shall consist of 1 youth-only ring of combined senior does and junior does.
3. The animals will show: Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian, AOP, and Recorded Grades; however, the ***order is subject to change***. If complications occur, then the show committee and judge will agree upon changes. This includes the time the show begins and ends.
4. For the Youth Show, the entry fee is \$7.00 per goat. **Goats entered in the Youth Show must be registered, recorded, or applied for in the youth exhibitor's name only.** All entries must be completed online in Showman App and paid in full by the registration deadline. There will be NO REFUNDS. ****RINGSIDE SUBSTITUTIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

a. Please Note: All entries **MUST** be in the name of the actual owner (youth exhibitor) as shown on the Original Registration Papers or on the Stamped Duplicate Registration Application. They may not be entered in any other name **PER ADGA SHOW RULES.**

b. Entries may be mailed with a check or money order to Southwest Missouri Dairy Goat Association, attn: Jasmine Bass, PO Box 44, Crane, MO 65633. Must be postmarked by 6/7/26.

5. Youth Showmanship is free; however, youth must pre-register through the Showman App using the Showmanship registration link by the entry deadline of June 11th.
6. No charge for youth showmanship or specialty group classes in shows, however to show in a breed the animal must be shown in a regular age class.
7. Entries from 06/07/2026 - 06/11/2026 WILL INCREASE– Youth -\$10.00/entry. No entries allowed after June 11, 2026 at 11:59p CST.
8. Base date for classes is 06/12/2026.
9. Pens are \$10 each and will be purchased on showman app on a first-come, first-serve basis. Pens ARE assigned in advance, and exhibitors are expected to use only the pens marked with the exhibitor's last name. **Exhibitors must comply with any adjustments or reassignments made by the Show Committee to accommodate space limitations.** Exhibitors may show off of a trailer, but be warned; announcements are hard to hear outside of the barns.
10. Goats may be examined on the grounds by fair personnel, veterinarians or state/federal personnel, and may be checked by the SMDGA Show Committee. Goats showing evidence of infectious abscesses WILL NOT be allowed to enter the barn or show and may be released. Goats showing evidence of any other illness may be released. **ALL goats, including in-state (MO) and out of State goats must have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with tattoo/tags/chip numbers of each goat. This paper will be examined at check-in.** Scrapie regulations will be in effect. All animals, including tag-a-longs, MUST have a scrapie tag or legible tattoos that match registration papers or applications. Animals will be checked at random. HEALTH CHECK COMMITTEE'S DECISION IS FINAL.
11. Camping will be permitted at the fairgrounds.
 - a. For tent/canopy/cot sleepers, you may set up in the community building or any unused outside area of the fairgrounds. There are plenty of outlets and restrooms in the community building.
 - b. For campers/RVs/trailers who need utility hookups, you may set up in the campground. The campground is equipped with electrical hookups. There are hydrants available for water in the general area, but not at every site. There is a fee of \$35 per night to stay in the campground. If you park in the campground, you must pay the fee. Upon paying the fee, you will receive a colored card that you must display on your vehicle on the side that faces the road. Display of this sign is mandatory as the show committee will be checking the campground throughout the weekend for unauthorized vehicles.
 - c. For campers/RVs/trailers that do not wish to stay in the campground, you may park in an open area on the fairgrounds. You may not run any type of electrical cord or water hose to any outlet on the fairgrounds.
12. All extension cords, fan cords, etc. must not be zip tied, tied with string, wire, etc, or in any way affixed to the metal pens. This is a safety issue for both the animals and humans due to the risk of the pens becoming electrified if the cord becomes physically damaged.
13. Any gas or propane fueled appliances, such as grills or camp stoves, must be used a minimum of 10 feet away from any building.
14. Showers will be available for all exhibitors.
15. Please consider our youth and set a good example for them. Anyone who is found with alcoholic beverages in their possession will be asked to relinquish them. Repeated offenders will be asked to leave the show entirely.

16. No smoking or vaping in any of the barns, show arena, restroom buildings, or the main building. Smoking/vaping is permitted outside of these areas.
17. Dogs are allowed on a 6 foot or shorter leash. They are not allowed in the show arena or in the show arena access chutes at any time. They must be attended at all times. Any dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior will need to be immediately removed from the fairgrounds.
18. The Newton County A & M Board, the Southwest Missouri Dairy Goat Association, the Show Committee, and all of their representatives and members, shall be held harmless from any liability from your participation in this show. This includes any and all illnesses, injuries, or death that your animals or yourself might incur during participation in the show.
19. Exhibitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible entity, and will not be allowed to attend the SMDGA show with a banned entity according to the SMDGA bylaws.
20. Any situation arising not covered by these rules or the breed association bylaws will be decided by the show committee. Protests must be made in writing and addressed to the SMDGA Board of Directors. Allow 30 days for a response.
21. Any person that is caught being disrespectful, rude, making false claims, or being physically or verbally abusive toward another exhibitor, judge, or committee member, will be immediately asked to leave the fairgrounds. If the person chooses not to leave when asked, security will be notified, and the person in question will be escorted from the grounds. There will be no refunds issued for any animals or services not yet rendered. This show has zero tolerance for this type of behavior.
22. The show rules and classes may be modified or added to by a member of the show committee to make the show run more efficiently.

SMDGA Boots 'n' Buckles Youth Dairy Goat Classic - Show Classes

Combined Senior/Junior Does - does that have freshened as well as does under 2 yrs having never freshened. Base date to calculate the appropriate class is 6/12/26.

Class 1 (Y1) - Junior Doe Kids born April 1 or after of 2026

Class 2 (Y2) - Intermediate Doe Kids born March 1 - March 31 of 2026

Class 3 (Y3) - Senior Doe Kids born January 1 - February 28 of 2026

Class 4 (Y4) - Junior Dry Yearling born June 15 - December 31 of 2025

Class 5 (Y5) - Senior Dry Yearling born June 15, 2024 - June 14, 2025

Class 6 (Y6) - Under 2 yrs old in milk

Class 7 (Y7) - 2 yrs to under 3 yrs old in milk

Class 8 (Y8) - 3 yrs to under 4 yrs old in milk

Class 9 (Y9) - 4 yrs to under 5 yrs old in milk

Class 10 (Y10) - 5 yrs and older in milk

*Junior Champion and Reserve Champion selection of each breed
Senior Champion and Reserve Champion selection of each breed
Best In Show*

If you plan to participate in showmanship, add the classes to your entries:

Peewee (SH1) - 3-5 yrs

Junior (SH2) - 6-10 yrs

Intermediate (SH3) - 11-14 yrs

Senior (SH4) - 15-19 yrs
